SYMBOLISM OF THE ADVENT WREATH CANDLES

PROPHECY CANDLE

On the first Sunday of Advent, the first purple candle is lit. This candle is typically called the "Prophecy Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, primarily Isaiah, who foretold the birth of Christ: (Isaiah 7:14). This first candle represents hope or expectation in anticipation of the coming Messiah.
